Review Questions

- 1. How old was Josiah when he became king? Eight years old.
- 2. Josiah did what was right in the eyes of whom? The Lord.
- 3. Josiah walked in the ways of which godly king: Saul, David, or Solomon? David.
- 4. What did Josiah begin to do when he was 16 years old: seek the Lord, throw out the idols, or build a temple? Seek the Lord.
- 5. When he was about 20 years old, what did Josiah begin to remove from Judah? High places (false places of worship), Asherim, carved and metal images (idols).
- **6.** What did Josiah have repaired? The temple/the house of the Lord.
- 7. What things left by two evil kings needed to be cleaned out of the temple? Idols.
- 8. Who did the repair work on the temple: Josiah's officials, the priests, or workmen? Workmen.
- 9. What did Hilkiah the priest find when the temple was being cleaned out? The Book of the Law.
- 10. When Hilkiah gave the Book of the Law to the king's secretary, what did the secretary do: read the book to himself, put the book on the king's shelf, or read the book to Josiah? Read the book to Josiah.
- 11. What did Josiah do to show his grief when he heard the words of the Lord? Tore his clothes.
- 12. Why did Josiah feel great sadness when he heard God's Word? He knew the people had not been doing what? *Following God's laws*.
- 13. Who gave Josiah's men a message from the Lord: the prophet Isaiah, the prophet Jeremiah, or the prophetess Huldah? The prophetess Huldah.
- 14. What did God say he was going to send on Judah as punishment for their idol worship? Disaster.
- 15. Because of Josiah's sadness over the people's sins, God made a promise to Josiah. What would happen before God sent disaster? *Josiah would die.*
- 16. What attribute of God means he is fair and must punish sin? *Just.*
- 17. How did Josiah die: from a battle wound, from a disease, or in a fire? From a battle wound.
- 18. How was King Josiah different from King Joash? Josiah stayed faithful to God to the end while Joash did not.
