Review Questions

Lesson 81

- 1. What Philistine king gave David and his men the city of Ziklag? *Achish*.
- 2. How did God spare David and his men from having to fight their own people when Achish brought them with him to a battle against the Israelites? The Philistine commanders sent them away and refused to let them fight.
- 3. What happened to Ziklag while David and his men were away with Achish? Amalekites raided the city, stole everything, and captured the people (their families).
- 4. What happened in the battle between the Philistines and the Israelites fighting under King Saul? The Israelites were defeated; Saul and three of his sons, including Jonathan, were killed.
- 5. After Saul's death, which tribe made David their king? *Judah*.
- 6. David was finally made king of all Israel after which son of Saul was killed? *Ish-bosheth*.

Lesson 82

- 7. Which city did David want to bring the ark of the covenant to? |erusalem.
- 8. What happened when Uzzah touched the ark because it was tipping on the cart? He was killed.
- 9. What was the correct way God told the people to carry the ark? The Levites were to carry the ark using long poles.
- 10. When the ark came safely to Jerusalem, what did David want to build for it? A permanent place of worship; a temple.
- 11. What did Nathan the prophet tell David about who would build the temple? David would not build it, but one of his sons would.
- 12. What special promise did God give David about one of his descendants? The King of kings, Jesus, would come from his family. Jesus would establish an eternal kingdom.

- 13. What was the name of the married woman David took for himself? *Bathsheba*.
- **14.** What did David do to cover up his sin? Had Bathsheba's husband, Uriah, killed.
- 15. Who did God send to David to confront him about his sin? *Nathan the prophet.*
- 16. What did Nathan tell David to get him to recognize his terrible sin? A parable about a rich man with many flocks who took and killed a poor man's pet lamb.
- 17. How did David respond when Nathan said that David was the rich man in the story? He admitted his sin and asked God for forgiveness; he repented.

Lesson 84

- 18. Which of David's sons killed one of his brothers and fled to another country? *Absalom*.
- 19. What did Absalom do when David brought him back to Jerusalem? He tried to take the kingdom away from David.
- **20.** What did Absalom look like? He was handsome with long hair.
- 21. Where did the battle between Absalom and David's men take place? A forest.
- 22. What happened to Absalom in the battle against David's men? He got caught in a tree and was killed by David's commander Joab and his men.
- 23. How did David and Absalom respond differently when they sinned? David repented and Absalom didn't.

Lesson 85

- 24. Which book of the Bible has the longest and the shortest chapters? *Psalms*.
- 25. Which kind of psalm is a cry to God for help or asks God why bad things have happened? *Psalm of lament.*

- **26.** Name another type of psalm. Psalm of praise, psalm of thanksgiving.
- **27.** Name a person who wrote a psalm. (Ask several students.) David, Solomon, Heman, Ethan, Asaph, Sons of Korah, Moses.

Lesson 86

- 28. Who did David choose to be king before he died? His son Solomon.
- 29. When Solomon became king, what did he ask God for? An understanding mind; wisdom.
- 30. God was pleased with Solomon's request, so he gave Solomon wisdom along with what other blessings? *Riches and honor.*
- 31. How did Solomon deal wisely between the two women who were fighting over a baby? He figured out who the real mother was by seeing who chose to protect the baby when he threatened to cut him in half.

- **32.** Who gave Solomon the plans for the temple? *His father, David.*
- 33. How else did David help prepare for the building of the temple? He collected materials like wood and precious metals.
- 34. How was the temple different from the tabernacle? The temple was a permanent (and beautiful) building in Jerusalem, not a portable tent/structure.
- 35. What piece of furniture, signifying God's presence, was placed in the Most Holy Place in the temple? *Ark of the covenant; ark of God.*
- 36. What did God send to show his pleasure and presence in the temple? Cloud.

Lesson 88

- 37. Who wrote many proverbs to teach his sons and the people? *King Solomon*.
- **38.** What is the purpose of a biblical proverb? To share a general truth for practical, godly living.

- **39. What is the first step to gaining wisdom?** *The fear of the Lord—understanding who he is and respecting him.*
- 40. What other practical things can we learn from Proverbs? (Allow several students to answer.) Being a good friend, honoring our parents, encouraging others, guarding our speech, being humble, and working hard.
- 41. Proverbs tells us to search for wisdom as we would search for what? *Hidden treasure.*
- 42. Will following the advice in Proverbs and living wisely save us from hell? No, we are only saved by faith in Jesus when we repent and trust in him.

- **43.** What commands for kings did Solomon disobey? He collected horses, gold, and silver. He married many foreign women.
- **44.** What sin did Solomon's foreign wives lead him into? *Worshipping false gods; idolatry.*
- **45.** What was God's punishment for Solomon's sin? He would take the kingdom away from his son and give it to his servant.
- 46. What was the name of Solomon's son who became king of the southern kingdom? *Rehoboam.*
- 47. What was the name of Solomon's servant who became king of the northern kingdom? *Jeroboam.*
- 48. What was the southern kingdom called? Judah.
- 49. What was the northern kingdom called? Israel.
- 50. What lessons can we learn from Solomon's mistakes? We can all be led astray by things in the world. Disobedience brings consequences/punishment. We are all sinners capable of putting other things above our love for God.
