
Instructions

Print on card stock and cut out two or more sets of game cards, depending on how many students or teams are playing and how long the game should last. Lay the cards out face down. Have students take turns flipping over two cards at a time—if the cards match, keep them and take another turn. Otherwise turn them back over and allow the next player to take a turn. Cards with a picture of the gift count as a wild card and can be matched with any other card. After all the cards are matched, have students count up the pairs of cards they collected to determine a winner.

Option: Print two sets of cards for each student to color and cut out. Provide plastic baggies for students to take their cards home in.

Show each card and discuss which covenant each picture represents and what students learned about it in today's lesson.
