- 1. What is the shortest chapter in the Bible? Psalm 117.
- 2. What type of psalm is Psalm 117: praise, lament, or thanksgiving? Praise.
- 3. What do psalms of praise help us do? Worship God in music and song.
- 4. How many psalms are there? 150.
- **5.** Where does Psalm 150:1 tell us to praise God? In his sanctuary and his mighty heavens. On earth and in heaven.
- **6.** Name one of the instruments used to praise God in Psalm 150. (Allow several students to answer.) *Trumpet, lute, harp, tambourine, strings, pipes, and cymbals.*
- 7. What are some ways we can praise God? Singing, praying, playing instruments, reading psalms to God.
- 8. What event led David to write Psalm 3? What was happening? He was fleeing from his son Absalom.
- 9. Psalm 3 is a psalm of lament. What does lament mean? Crying out to God and asking God why.
- 10. Who did the writer of Psalm 43 turn to when he was feeling sad and low? *God.*
- 11. What type of psalm reminds us to give thanks to God? Psalm of thanksgiving.
- **12.** In Psalm 136, the writer gives thanks to God because what attribute endures forever? *Steadfast love; mercy.*
- **13.** Name something we can thank God for. Who he is and the things he has done (e.g., his attributes, creation, mighty deeds, answers to prayer).
- 14. Who wrote over 70 of the psalms? King David.
- 15. Name one of the three psalms of David we mentioned today. Psalm 51, Psalm 3, Psalm 18.
- 16. How many writers' names do we have for the psalms? Seven.
- 17. True or false: the psalms are a collection of prayers and songs. True.
- **18.** Name another writer God guided to write a psalm besides David. (Allow several students to answer.) Asaph, Sons of Korah, Moses, Solomon, Heman, Ethan.
- 19. True or false: Psalms is the largest book of the Bible. *True*.
- 20. Where is Psalms located in the Bible: the beginning, middle, or end? Middle.
- 21. What psalm is our memory verse from? Psalm 32.
