## OutWord *For Family Discussion*

Suppose your friend says he doesn't understand how God can allow hard things in his life—or anyone's life! **What could you say?**

*Hard things happen to everyone, both Christians and non-Christians. And that is difficult to understand sometimes. But did you know that Jesus told his disciples (and us through his Word) that they would have trials? However, he also told them that he would bring them a special peace through the Holy Spirit. And because of the*

*peace that Jesus brings, the difficulties are easier to handle. This is a very special peace that only comes from knowing him, trusting him, and believing that he is the Son of God. In order to receive the peace that Jesus offers, we must turn away from our sins and commit our lives to trusting and following him.*
