Covenant Wall Hanger

Materials

- ☐ Covenant Pictures printed on card stock (next page)
- ☐ Colored craft sticks
- ☐ Glue
- ☐ Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- ☐ Yarn or ribbon, cut into 6-inch pieces
- ☐ lewel stickers

Instructions

Print and cut out one Covenant Picture on card stock for each student. Have students color the pictures then glue craft sticks onto the crossed lines in the middle to form a cross. (These will overlap a bit.)

Next, have students run a bead of glue across the top edge and place the two ends of a piece of yarn into the glue to form a loop for hanging. Place a craft stick across the top edge, covering the yarn ends. Attach a craft stick to the bottom edge of the picture, then glue two sticks on each side. (You may choose to overlap the sticks, or they can stick out a little on the ends.)

After the sticks are in place, decorate them with jewel stickers. Allow glue to dry before hanging.



Suggested Discussion
