- 1. What prophet did we read about today? Jonah.
- 2. What city did God tell Jonah to go preach to: Nineveh, Joppa, or Tarshish? Nineveh.
- 3. What were the Assyrians who lived in Nineveh like? They were wicked and cruel.
- **4.** Why didn't Jonah want to go to Nineveh? Jonah (and the Jewish people) didn't like the Assyrians. He didn't want God to show mercy on his enemies.
- **5.** True or false: Jonah obeyed God and headed to Nineveh immediately. False. He got on a ship headed in the opposite direction (to Tarshish). He tried to run from God's presence.
- 6. Which attribute of God means all-powerful? Omnipotent.
- 7. We can't run away from God. Which attribute of God means he is everywhere? Omnipresent.
- 8. What did God send to stop Jonah's ship? Terrible storm, tempest.
- 9. What was Jonah doing during the storm? Sleeping.
- 10. What happened when the crew tossed Jonah overboard? The storm stopped.
- 11. What did God send to swallow Jonah? Great fish.
- **12.** How long was Jonah in the belly of the fish: one week, three days and nights, or 24 hours? *Three days and nights*.
- 13. What did Jonah finally do from the belly of the fish? He prayed.
- 14. What did God cause the fish to do to Jonah after he repented? Vomit him up on dry land.
- 15. What did Jonah do once he was back on land? He obeyed God and went to Nineveh.
- 16. Jonah said God was going to destroy Nineveh in 40 days unless the people did what? Repented.
- 17. The people of Nineveh showed repentance by fasting and putting on: dress clothes, robes, or sackcloth? *Sackcloth*.
- 18. God showed grace and mercy to Nineveh because the people repented of their sins. God chose not to do *what* to the city? *Destroy it.*
- 19. How did Jonah feel about God's mercy toward Nineveh? He was angry and displeased.
- 20. Jonah needed to learn that God wants to show love and mercy to whom? All people, everyone.
