Review Questions

- 1. Why did Joseph's brothers travel to Egypt? Because of the famine, they needed to buy grain.
- 2. Who was in charge of selling grain in Egypt? Joseph.
- 3. Why didn't the brothers recognize Joseph? He looked and sounded Egyptian and had an Egyptian name. It had been many years since they had seen him.
- 4. What did Joseph accuse his brothers of being? Spies.
- 5. Who did Joseph put in prison until the brothers came back with Benjamin? Simeon.
- 6. Why were the brothers worried when they found their money in their grain sacks? They thought they used that money to pay for the grain, so it would look like they'd taken it back.
- 7. Why didn't Jacob want Benjamin to go to Egypt? He was worried something bad would happen to him.
- 8. Which brother took responsibility for Benjamin's safety on the trip to Egypt? Judah.
- 9. Who put Joseph's silver cup in Benjamin's sack of grain? Joseph's steward.
- **10.** How did Joseph test his brothers to see if they had changed? (Allow several students to answer.) He gave Benjamin more food than his brothers. He put his silver cup in Benjamin's sack so it would look like he'd stolen it. Then Joseph said he'd make Benjamin his servant to see if his brothers would stand up for him and protect him.
- 11. What did Judah offer to do to save Benjamin? Take his place/punishment to stay as a servant.
- **12. Why were the brothers afraid when Joseph said who he was?** *They thought he would want revenge for what they did to him.*
- **13.** What did Joseph understand about God that helped him forgive his brothers? *God is sovereign. God was in control of everything that happened.*
- 14. Joseph's brothers meant evil against him, but what good did God cause to come from Joseph's slavery in Egypt? Joseph became the ruler who prepared for the famine and saved many people.
- 15. What did Jacob decide to do when he heard that Joseph was alive? Move to Egypt to see him.
- 16. What land did Pharaoh give to Jacob (Israel) and his family when they came to Egypt? Goshen.
- 17. Who can fill in some missing words from the memory verse? Read the verse and pause at the blanks to let student provide the words.
