

Joseph's Coat

Materials

- ☐ Coat pattern (following page)
- ☐ Felt in a variety of colors
- ☐ Small plastic bags

Instructions

Print and cut out one coat pattern. Use the pattern to cut out one coat from the felt for each student. Cut out a variety of shapes from different colors of felt (stripes, circles, triangles, etc.) enough for each student to have several pieces. For older students, you could have them cut out their own shapes.



Have students stick the shapes onto the felt coat to make their own “coat of many colors.” No glue needed! The felt should stick to itself and peel up again for another use.

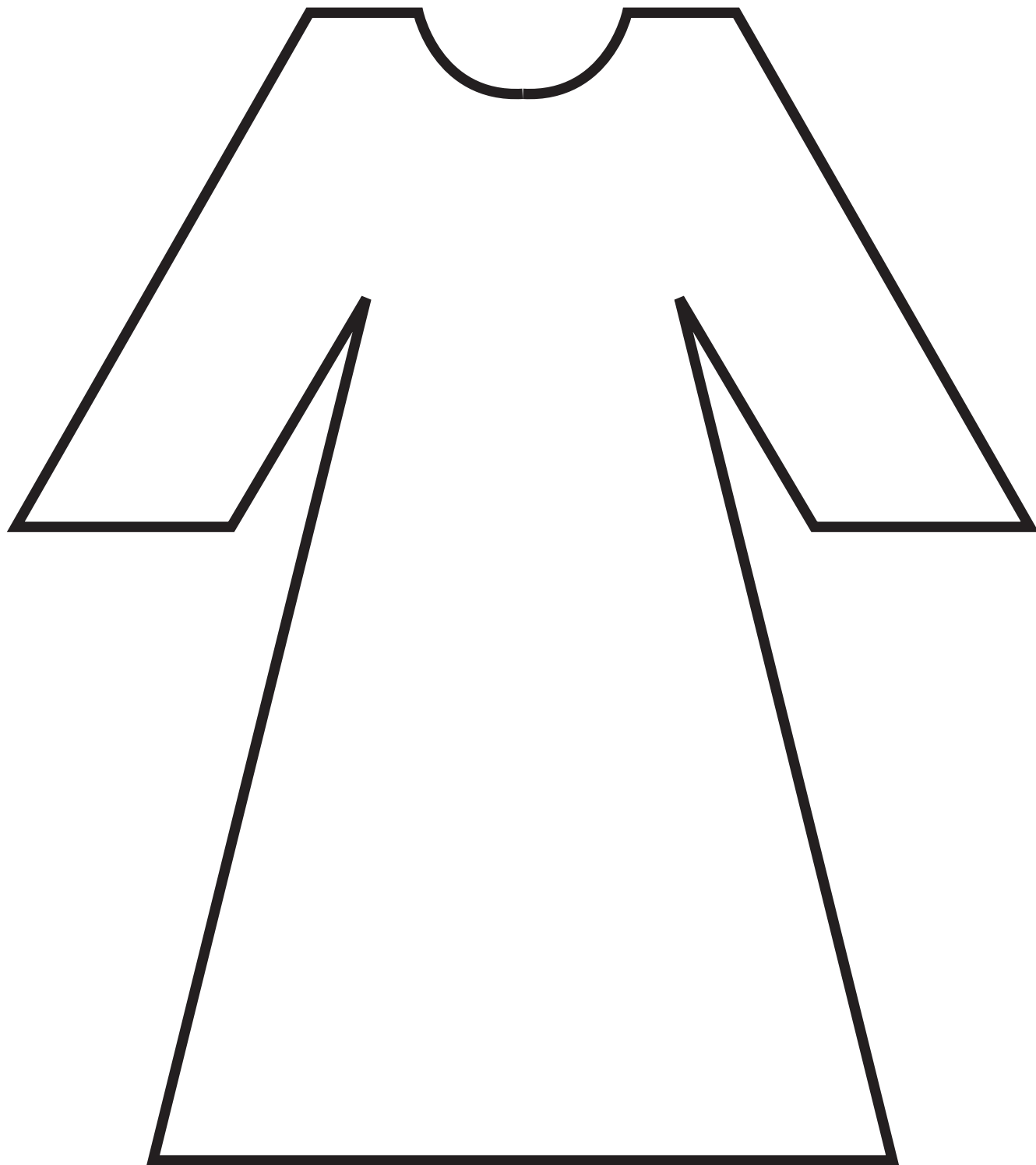
Provide one small bag for each student to take the coat and felt pieces home.

Suggested Discussion

Jacob loved Joseph more than his other sons, and he treated Joseph as his favorite. One of the special things he did for Joseph was to give him a coat with many colors in it.

Allow students to name some colors.
