Review Questions

- 1. What did kings usually do in the springtime? Go to war.
- 2. Did David choose to lead his army or to stay home? Stay home.
- 3. While David was home, whom did he see and want for his wife? Bathsheba.
- 4. Why was it a sin for David to want Bathsheba as his wife? She was already married to someone else!
- 5. What is God's plan for marriage, which David knew? One man and one woman together for life.
- **6.** Who was Bathsheba's husband? Uriah, one of David's fighting men.
- 7. How did David get rid of Uriah so he could marry Bathsheba? He gave the order to have Uriah killed in battle.
- **8.** Which three commandments did David disobey? Allow several students to answer. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not covet.
- 9. Who did God send to David to tell him a parable? *Nathan the prophet*.
- 10. Who were the characters in Nathan's parable, or story? Rich man, poor man, traveler, little lamb.
- **11. What did the rich man do in the story?** He took the poor man's lamb, his pet, and killed it to feed the traveler instead of using one of his own lambs.
- 12. How did David respond when he heard the story? Who was he angry at? He was angry at the rich man.
- **13. What punishment did David say the rich man deserved?** He deserved to die. He should repay the poor man with lambs for the one he took and killed.
- 14. What did Nathan say to David so he would understand the rich man in the parable was him? You are the man!
- 15. What did David do when he understood his sin was not hidden from God? He confessed his sin to God.
- **16.** What did God do when David asked for forgiveness? He forgave David.
- **17. What consequences did Nathan say David would have because of his sin?** His child with Bathsheba would die. His family would have trouble.
- 18. What attribute did David ask God to show him? It means that God withholds deserved punishment. *Mercy.*
- 19. Like David, what problem do we have that makes us want to go our own way? Sin. Temptation.
- **20. What can we do to keep from giving in to temptation?** *Pray, ask for God's help, turn away from it, ask someone for help, meditate on God's Word, etc.*
