## K-1st Review Questions

- 11. When the people met outside the temple during the rain, what two things made them tremble? Their sin and the heavy rain.
- 12. How did the foreign wives lead the Jews to sin? What did they teach their husbands and children to do? Worship false gods.
- 13. What did the people do when Ezra reminded them of God's commands: shouted at Ezra, laughed, or asked God for forgiveness? Asked God for forgiveness.
- 14. What was the consequence for the people's sin? Who had to be sent away? The foreign wives and children.
