

Sunshine Photo Holder

Materials

- ☐ Text Circles (next page)
- ☐ Sturdy yellow or orange paper plates (9-inch)
- ☐ Hot glue gun
- ☐ Wooden clothespins (8 for each student)
- ☐ Crayons and markers in shades of yellow and orange
- ☐ Liquid glue
- ☐ Decorations: glitter, small buttons, beads, pom-poms, jewel stickers, narrow ribbon, yarn, etc.
- ☐ Round, self-adhesive magnets (2 for each student)



Instructions

Do ahead: use a hot glue gun to glue one inside edge of each clothespin handle to the back of the rim around the plate. (Bring the glue gun to class for quick repairs while students are making their crafts.)

During class: print one Text Circle for each student. Have students cut out and color the circle then glue it in the center of their paper plate. Have them color the top side of each clothespin with crayons or markers.

Have students decorate the edges and center of their plate with small buttons, beads, pom-poms, jewel stickers, ribbon, yarn, etc.

Attach 2 round magnets to the back of the plate. Squeeze the handles at the edge of the plate to open the clothespins and insert photos.

Suggested Discussion
