

What You Heard In the Word

- The people of Judah would not listen to Jeremiah's warnings. Instead, they punished him by putting him into a cistern where he sunk into the mud. He was later rescued by the king's servant, Ebed-Melech.
- · God used King Nebuchadnezzar and his Babylonian army to punish the people of Judah for their sin: the city of Jerusalem was attacked, the temple was burned, and people were killed or taken away to Babylon.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. Why did God bring the Babylonian army to attack the city of Jerusalem? To punish the people for their sin.
- 2. Where did the people put Jeremiah because they didn't like his message of warning? They cast him into a cistern/pit.

3. How did Ebed-Melech help Jeremiah when he was in the pit? He asked the king to let Jeremiah out. He took 30 men and pulled Jeremiah out with ropes.
