


God Defends His Glory

When Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were in the fiery furnace, God protected them. Use the color guide to finish the picture.





- Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego chose to obey God and would not bow to Nebuchadnezzar's statue. When the king had them thrown into the fiery furnace, God showed his great power and glory by protecting and saving them.
- Nebuchadnezzar was a very proud king and wanted the credit for all he had done. God punished him for sinful pride by causing him to live like an animal for seven years until he finally understood that God is in control over everything and everyone.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. Why did King Nebuchadnezzar throw Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego into a fiery furnace? *They would not worship his statue. They would only worship God.*
- 2. How did God protect Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in the furnace? He sent a fourth man (his Son or an angel) to be with them. He did not let them be hurt by the fire.
- 3. What was King Nebuchadnezzar's punishment for his sinful pride? He had to live in the fields and eat grass like an animal.
