Lesson 61

1. Name one of the men God promised to give the land of Canaan. *Repeat question to several students at bat. Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Moses.*
2. How many spies did Moses send into the promised land? *Twelve.*
3. What did 10 of the spies see in the land that made them fearful and give a bad report to the Israelites? *Giants and walled (fortified) cities.*
4. What did the people want to do when they heard the bad report of the 10 spies? *Return to Egypt.*
5. What two spies had faith in God's promises and tried to convince the people to obey God? *Joshua and Caleb.*
6. How did God punish the people for rebelling against him and refusing to enter the promised land? *They wandered in the wilderness for 40 years until the adults 20 and older died.*

Lesson 62

7. Name one of the three men who rebelled against God and Moses during the years in the wilderness. *Repeat question to several students at bat. Korah, Dathan, Abiram.*
8. What did the 250 leaders who offered incense want to be? *Priests.*
9. How did God show mercy to the people before he punished the rebels? *He had Moses warn them to move away from the rebels.*
10. How did God punish Korah, Dathan, and Abiram? *An earthquake; the ground opened up and swallowed them.*
11. When the Israelites became impatient and complained to Moses about food and water, what punishment did God send throughout the camp that killed some people? *Fierly serpents/poisonous snakes.*

12. The bronze serpent that Moses set up in the camp to heal the people from their snakebites was a picture of whom? *Jesus on the cross.*

13. What two powerful Amorite kings attacked the Israelites but were defeated? *Sihon and Og.*
14. Which tribes asked Moses if they could stay in the lands they took from Sihon and Og? *Repeat question to several students at bat. Reuben, Gad, and half-tribe of Manasseh.*
15. What was the name of the false prophet hired by the king of Moab to curse the Israelites? *Balaam.*
16. Who stood in the road to block Balaam from going to King Balak? *Angel of the Lord.*
17. Who saved Balaam's life and spoke to him? *Balaam's donkey.*
18. What did God have Balaam say about the Israelites when he was with King Balak—blessings or curses? *Blessings.*

19. Where did God have Moses go to see the promised land before he died? *A mountain.*
20. Who did God choose to lead the Israelites after Moses' death? *Joshua.*
21. What city did Joshua send the two spies to? *Jericho.*
22. What woman hid the spies on her roof and helped them escape the city? *Rahab.*
23. What did Rahab believe about God when she heard about his miracles for the Israelites? *That he was the one true God.*
24. What did the spies tell Rahab to do so she and her family would be spared when they took over the city? *Tie a scarlet cord in her window. Gather all her family inside her house. Not tell her people their plans.*

25. What obstacle was in between the Israelites' camp and the city of Jericho? *Jordan River.*
26. What did God command the priests to carry when they led the way to the river? *Ark of the covenant.*
27. What did the priests have to do to show their faith before God worked a miracle? *Put their feet in the water.*
28. What miracle did God perform to allow the Israelites to cross the flooded Jordan River? *He blocked the river miles away so it stopped flowing.*
29. What were the Israelites supposed to remember when they saw the 12 memorial stones Joshua set up on the other side of the river? *God's miracle to stop the Jordan River so they could cross over.*
