

Israel Turns to Idols


Judges 2:14–16, 3:7–9

God often blesses us with many things. But we must not let them turn into idols. Draw a line to match the pictures then color them.






















What You Heard In the Word

- For about 300 years, Israel repeated a cycle of idol worship and disobeying God.
- Whenever we make anything more important than God, it can become an idol.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- What did the Israelites do that started a cycle of sin? Worshipped false gods/idols.
- What did God do when the Israelites cried out for help? He chose a judge to lead and fight for them.
