## K-1st Review Questions

- 1. The Israelites were living as captives in what nation: Babylon or Syria? *Babylon*.
- God had promised that the Jews would only be in Babylon for how many years? 70.
- After the Jews had been in Babylon for awhile, who took over Babylon: the Egyptians, the Persians, or the Syrians? The Persians.
- 4. Who was the king of Persia? Cyrus.
- 5. What word means that God is in control over everything: holy, loving, or sovereign? Sovereign.
- 6. What did God command Cyrus to build for him in Jerusalem? A house for God. The temple.
- 7. What did King Cyrus give the Jews permission to do? To leave Persia and go back home to Judah.
- 8. Name one of the gifts the king told everyone to give to the Jews who were leaving. (Ask several students.) Silver, gold, animals.
- 9. Who did God choose to lead this first group of Jews home? *Zerubbabel*.
- 10. What was the first thing Zerubbabel led the people to rebuild so that they could worship the Lord: the altar, the steps, or a tower? *The altar.*
- 11. What part of the temple had to be finished first to keep the building straight and strong: the steps, the foundation, or the columns? *The foundation*.
- 12. How did some of the people living in Jerusalem feel about the Jews rebuilding the temple? They did not want the temple to be built. They were not happy about it.
- 13. What did some of the people do to keep the Jews from rebuilding the temple? They tried to scare them.
- 14. How many years did the people have to wait before finishing the temple: 2, 21, or 51? 21.
- 15. When the temple was finished, how did the people celebrate? With joy. They offered sacrifices to God in the temple. They sang songs and prayed.
- 16. What word means that God will keep his promises? *Faithful*.
- 17. Where is our memory verse found? 1 Peter 5:10.
