## What You Heard *In the Word*

- Nehemiah prayed and trusted God to help him rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.
- Enemies tried to stop the work, but Nehemiah armed the Jews to defend themselves while they continued to build. God protected the people as the walls were completed.

*Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:*

1. What bad news did Nehemiah hear about Jerusalem? *The walls of the city were broken down and the gates were destroyed.*
2. As they did their work, what did the Jews keep nearby to be ready for an enemy attack? *Weapons.*
3. What was Nehemiah's plan to gather the people quickly if they were attacked? *A man would sound the alarm on a trumpet.*
