

# Review Questions

1. What city did King David choose as his capital city? *Jerusalem.*
2. What holy object did David want to bring to Jerusalem? *Ark of God, ark of the covenant.*
3. What did the ark of the covenant look like? *Gold-covered box with cherubim (angels) on top.*
4. What did the ark represent? *The presence of God.*
5. Who had captured the ark of God during the time of Samuel? *The Philistines.*
6. Why did the Philistines decide they didn't want to keep the ark anymore? *God sent plagues and fear upon them because of the ark.*
7. How did the Philistines send the ark back to Israel? *They put it on a cart pulled by milk cows.*
8. Many years later, when David and the people went to get the ark, how did they try to move it? What did they put it on? *A new cart pulled by oxen.*
9. Why did Uzzah touch the ark? *He tried to steady it when the oxen pulling the cart stumbled.*
10. What happened to Uzzah when he touched the ark? *He died.*
11. Why was Uzzah punished for touching the ark? *The people weren't following God's commands for how to move the ark. Uzzah did not treat the ark of God with fear and respect.*
12. How did David and the Israelites move the ark the second time? *Levites carried it on their shoulders using poles.*
13. Where was the ark placed in Jerusalem? *In a tent David had pitched for it.*
14. What did David decide he wanted to do for the ark of God? *Build a glorious temple for it.*
15. What prophet brought God's message to David? *Nathan.*
16. Who did God say would build the temple? *One of David's sons.*
17. What promise did God give to David about his descendants? Who would be born into his family? *Jesus. The Messiah. The King of kings.*
18. What does the word *messiah* mean? *Anointed (to be king).*
19. How long would this special king reign? *Forever.*
20. Name one of the five descriptions Isaiah gave for the child who would be born to save us. (Allow several students to answer.) Give the first word of each for a hint, if necessary. *A son, Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.*
