



Israel Receives a Land

Joshua 11:4, 11:6, 14:11-12

God gave the land to the Israelites like he promised. Joshua divided it up so all the people could go and live in their own land. Help the Israelites follow each path from the middle out to their new homes and the good things in the land.





What You Heard In the Word

- God was faithful to keep his promises to Abraham to make his descendants into a great nation and to give each tribe part of the Promised Land.
- God helped Joshua lead the Israelites to take the land as their own, and he helped Caleb fight giants for the hill country.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. Who were Abraham's descendants that God promised the land of Canaan to? *The Israelites*.
- 2. What happened when Caleb trusted God to help him fight the giants? *He won!* He got the hill country for his own.
- 3. What was the land like when the Israelites took it over and moved in? They could use what was already there, like the cities, houses, trees, vegetables, and fruit.
