- 1. Who did God promise to save from slavery hundreds of years before it happened? *Abram's descendants, the Israelites.*
- 2. How did God keep his promise to give the people "great possessions" when they left Egypt? The Israelites asked the Egyptians for their jewelry and clothes, and the Egyptians gave it to them.
- 3. What does it mean when we say that God is faithful? He will always keep his promises.
- 4. The event of the Israelites leaving Egypt is called what? The Exodus.
- 5. How did God lead the Israelites by day on their journey? By a pillar of cloud.
- 6. How did God lead the Israelites by night on their journey? By a pillar of fire.
- 7. Why did God lead the Israelites through the wilderness instead of the land of the Philistines? He didn't want them to have to fight the Philistines for fear they would turn back to Egypt.
- 8. How did Pharaoh feel after they left? He was sorry he let them go.
- 9. What did Pharaoh and the Egyptians decide to do? Chase after the Israelites and bring them back.
- 10. How many chariots did Pharaoh have? 600 or more.
- 11. Where did the Israelites get trapped? At the Red Sea.
- **12.** How did God miraculously provide a way of escape for the Israelites? He parted the Red Sea so they could cross on dry ground.
- **13. What did God do to stop Pharaoh's chariots?** He made the wheels get clogged so they wouldn't work right.
- **14. Why did Pharaoh's army want to turn back?** They realized that God was fighting against them.
- **15.** What happened when Pharaoh and his army followed the Israelites into the sea? God caused the sea to return to its usual place, drowning the Egyptians.
