## **What You Heard** *In the Word*

- David gave in to temptation and sinned when he took Uriah's wife and then tried to cover up his sin by having Uriah killed.
- God revealed David's sin to him through a parable, and he forgave David when he cried out to him in repentance.

## **OutWord** *For Family Discussion*

What if your friend said that he has done too many bad things for God to forgive.

### **What could you say?**

*Everybody sins. You may think you've committed too many sins to be forgiven, but God is able to forgive you. God must judge sin, and a penalty must be paid in order for your sins to be forgiven. The good news is that God sent his Son, Jesus, to pay that penalty for us. If you ask God to forgive you and trust in Jesus to be your Savior, he will forgive all your sins. You can start fresh by walking in obedience to God. You can read about King David in the Bible. He was called a "man after God's own heart," but he committed terrible sins, including murder. When he repented and asked God to take away his sin, God forgave him.*
