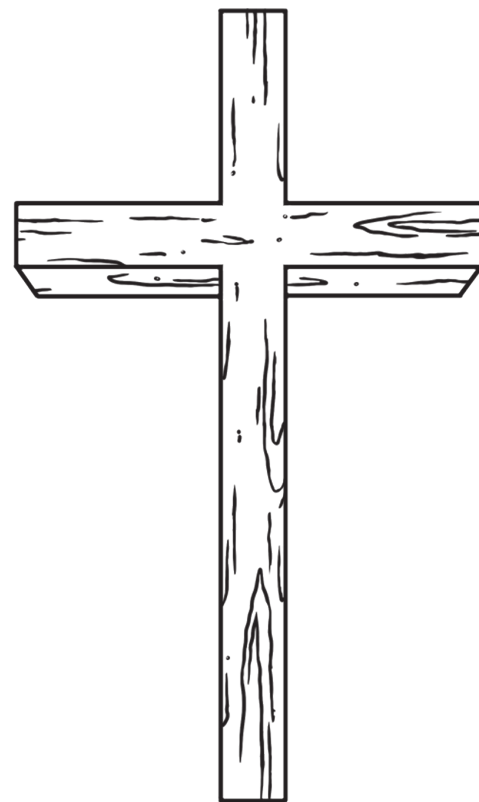
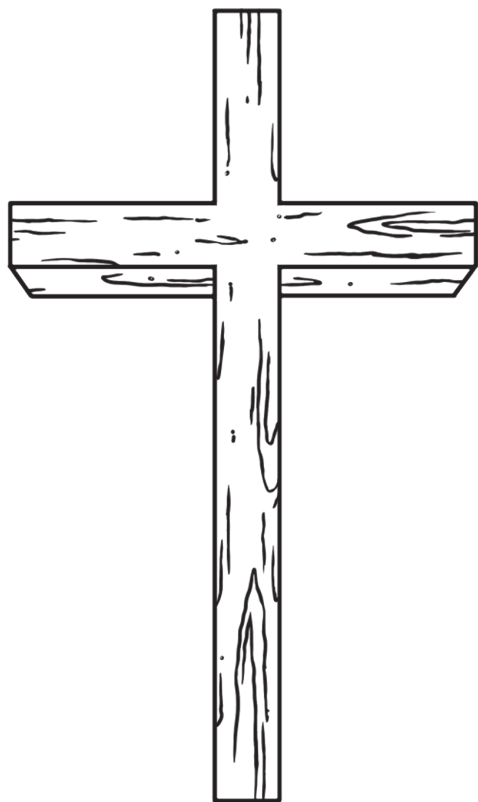
- ☐ One or more sets of the picture cards (following page) on card stock

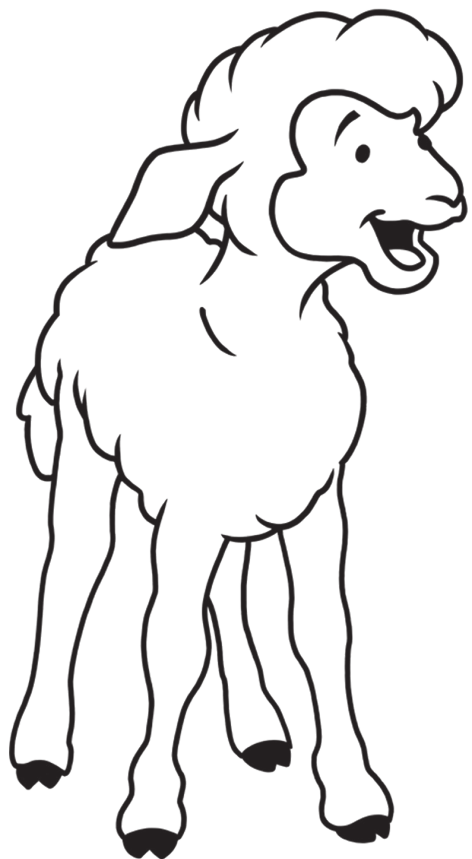
Instructions

Print on card stock and cut out one or more sets of the picture cards for every two players. Divide the class into groups of 2–4 students. Have each group lay their cards facedown on a table or the floor. Students will take turns choosing two cards to flip over. If the cards match, the player keeps them and takes another turn. If the cards do not match, the player turns them back over and the next player takes a turn. Continue until all the matched pairs are found. The player with the most matched sets wins the game.

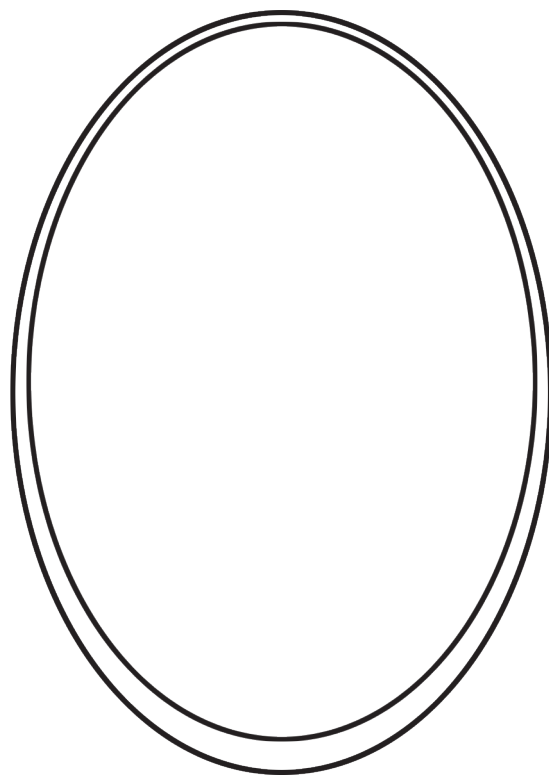
Suggested Discussion
