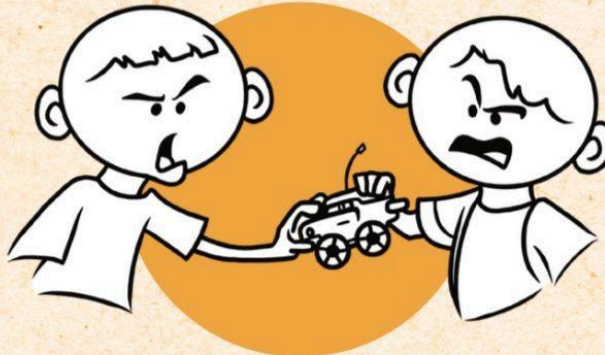

What You Heard *In the Word*

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

2. What kind of song did Mary sing? Did she sing about how great she was or how great God is? *She sang about God's greatness and praised him.*
3. How did God guide Joseph to make the right decision about Mary? *He sent an angel in a dream to explain to Joseph what he should do.*
