What You Heard *In the Word*

- The four Gospels were written by four men—and all show something special about Jesus.
- Matthew shows Jesus as the promised King; Mark shows Jesus as a suffering servant; Luke shows Jesus as the Son of Man who seeks and saves the lost; and John shows Jesus as the Son of God, who saves those who believe.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What does the word gospel mean? *Good news.*
2. What does it mean to repent of our sins? *To turn away from sin and do what's right.*
3. When Jesus came as a servant, what did he do to pay the ransom for sinners? *He died on the cross.*
