Review Questions

- 1. Which of Joseph's two sons received the better blessing from Israel: Manasseh or Ephraim? *Ephraim, the younger brother.*
- 2. Why did Israel call his 12 sons to him before he died? He wanted to bless them.
- 3. Did Israel give blessings that would happen to his sons or to his sons' descendants called tribes? His sons' descendants, the tribes of Israel.
- 4. Which son received the leadership of the family with kings in his family line? *Judah.*
- 5. Who is the promised King who will have the obedience of all the people of the earth? Jesus.
- 6. Which tribe of Israel did Jesus come from? Judah's.
- 7. What symbol represented the rulers and kings who would come from the tribe of Judah? Scepter.
- **8.** Name a king who came from Judah's line. Allow several students to answer based on the genealogy in *Illustration #2*.
- 9. What strong animal was used to describe the tribe of Judah? Lion.
- **10.** How was Joseph blessed? He would be fruitful, have many descendants.
- 11. Where was Israel buried, in Egypt or in Canaan? Canaan.
- 12. Which son of Israel believed God's promise that the Israelites would one day return to the land of Canaan? *Joseph*.
- **13.** What did Joseph ask his descendants to bring with them when they returned to Canaan one day? His bones.
- 14. How old was Joseph when he died: 90, 100, or 110? 110.
- **15.** Why was the new king (Pharaoh) of Egypt afraid of the Israelites? They were more numerous than the Egyptians. They could fight against them.
- 16. What did the new Pharaoh do to the Israelites because he was afraid? He made them slaves.
- **17.** Name one of the tasks the Israelites were forced to do as slaves. (Allow several students to answer.) Build cities, make bricks, work in the fields, plant crops, etc.
- **18.** Based on Romans 8:28, we know that all things work together for good for whom? Those who love God, those who are called according to his purpose.
- **19.** Who can recite the memory verse? Allow several students to recite the verse.
