## **Review Questions**

- 1. Why was Esther raised by her cousin Mordecai? Her parents had died.
- 2. What country were Esther and Mordecai living in? Persia.
- 3. Who was the king of Persia in the book of Esther: Ahasuerus, Belshazzar, or Cyrus? Ahasuerus.
- 4. Why were all the beautiful, young women gathered and brought to the palace? The king was looking for a new queen.
- 5. Why didn't Mordecai want Esther to use the name Hadassah? She would be recognized as a Jew.
- 6. Name one of the things the servant Hegai did for Esther in the palace. (Allow several students to answer.) He gave her cosmetics (beauty treatments), food, servants, and the best place in the house.
- 7. What did the king give Esther to show she was chosen to be queen? Royal crown.
- 8. What did God arrange for Mordecai to overhear at the king's gate? Two servants plotting to kill the king.
- 9. How did Mordecai stop the plot? He told Esther, who told the king, and the king had the two men killed.
- 10. Who rose to a powerful position in Persia? Haman.
- 11. Who made Haman angry by refusing to bow to him? Mordecai.
- 12. To get revenge, Haman determined to kill not only Mordecai but also what people? All the Jews.
- 13. Haman got the king to sign a decree to destroy the Jews because he said they didn't keep the king's what? *Laws*.
- **14.** What did Mordecai and the Jews do when they heard this decree that they be killed? *They mourned, fasted, and wept.*
- **15.** What did Mordecai ask Esther to do? Go before the king and plead for their lives.
- **16.** Why was it dangerous for Esther to appear before the king uninvited? If he wasn't pleased to see her, he could have her killed.
- 17. What did Esther ask Mordecai and the Jews to do before she went before the king? Fast for three days.
- **18.** Why did God keep the king from sleeping one night? So the king would call for the chronicles to be read to him and remember how Mordecai had saved his life.
- **19.** What did the king do to show his favor to Esther when she approached his throne? Held out his scepter.
- 20. When did Esther reveal Haman's plot and beg the king to save her and her people: in the throne room, at her first banquet, or at her second banquet? *At her second banquet*.
- **21.** How did the king punish Haman? He was hung on the gallows he built to kill Mordecai.
- **22.** With the king's permission, how did Esther and Mordecai stop the Jews from being destroyed? They sent out letters to cancel (revoke) Haman's previous decree and to allow the Jews to defend themselves.
- 23. Whose name is not mentioned in the book of Esther even though we see him clearly controlling all the people and events? *God.* 
  - Bonus: Name the Jewish holiday that celebrates the defeat of Haman and the salvation of the Jews. *Purim.*
