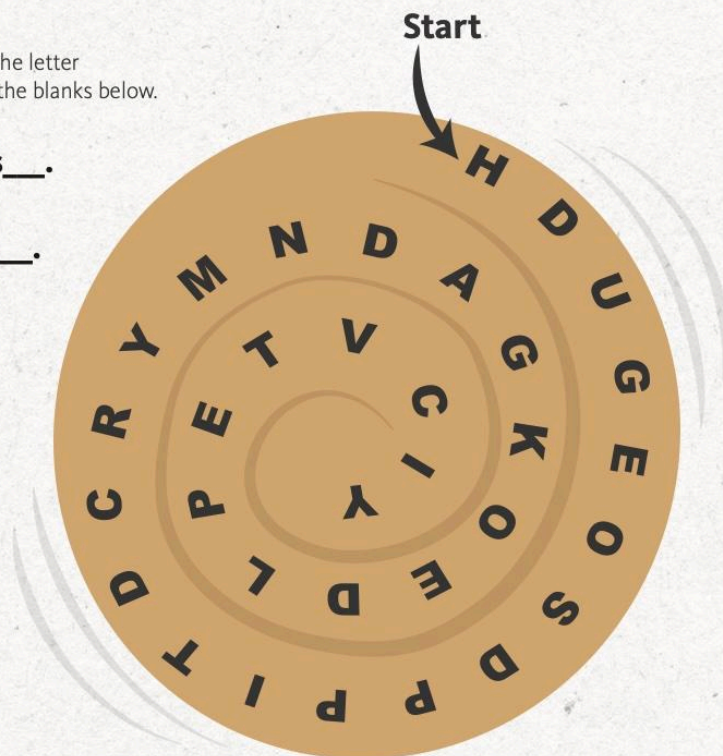

What You Heard *In the Word*

Out Word *For Family Discussion*

Suppose your Christian friend says that she feels worthless she doesn't even know why she's alive.

What could you say?

You're not worthless! God made you special in his image. God told Jeremiah the prophet that he had a special purpose for him before he was even born, and the same is true for you.
