- 1. What consequences did God tell David he would have because of his sin with Bathsheba? His baby would die and his family would have conflict.
- 2. What did Absalom do that forced him to flee to Geshur? He had his brother Amnon killed.
- 3. Absalom's murder of his brother was like David's murder of whom? Bathsheba's husband, Uriah.
- 4. What did Absalom weigh every year? His hair after it was cut.
- 5. What did Absalom look like? He was handsome/good-looking. He had no blemish.
- 6. How did Absalom choose to travel around the city? In a chariot with horses and 50 men.
- 7. How did Absalom get the men of Israel to like him when they came to the city gate? He treated them as equals. He said their case was important to him but not to his father.
- 8. In what city did Absalom gather his supporters against David: Jerusalem, Hebron, or Bethlehem? *Hebron*.
- 9. What did David do when he heard that Absalom was plotting to take over the throne? Fled from lerusalem with his household and servants.
- **10.** How did David's friends who stayed in Jerusalem help him? They reported to David what Absalom was doing and gave bad advice to Absalom.
- 11. What were David's loyal, experienced soldiers called: gladiators, mighty men, or samurai? Mighty men.
- 12. Where did the battle between David and Absalom's men take place? In a forest.
- 13. What killed more men: the trees in the forest or the swords of the soldiers? The trees in the forest.
- 14. Who won the battle? David's men.
- **15. What happened to Absalom during the battle?** His hair/neck caught in a tree and his mule ran away, leaving him hanging.
- **16.** Who found Absalom hanging there and killed him? *Joab and his armor-bearers.*
- 17. Was Absalom's death considered an honorable or a humiliating death? Humiliating.

- 19. When David was back in Jerusalem years after the trouble with Absalom, what did David order his commander Joab to do? Count all the fighting men of Israel.
- **20.** What punishment from God did David choose for his sin by taking a census? *Three days of plague/pestilence.*
- **21. What were the other two punishment options God gave David?** Three years of famine and three months of fleeing from enemies; famine and sword.
- **22.** How did God show mercy in the punishment? He stopped the plague when David cried for mercy.
