What You Heard *In the Word*

- During a feast, proud King Belshazzar misused the special cups meant for worshipping God. Then God sent a human hand to write a message to Belshazzar on the wall. Belshazzar's punishment for his sinful pride would come that night, and his kingdom would be taken over by others.
- King Darius was tricked into signing a new law forbidding prayer to any god but him. Daniel chose to obey the true God and continue to pray. As punishment, Daniel was thrown into the lions' den. After God protected Daniel from the hungry lions, King Darius believed that Daniel's God was the true God.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. How did God send a message to the proud King Belshazzar? *He sent a human hand to write on the wall.*
2. How was Daniel punished for praying to God? *He was thrown into the lions' den.*
3. How did God keep Daniel safe in the lions' den? *He sent an angel and shut the lions' mouths.*
