1. What book of history in the Bible did we read from today: Joshua, 2 Kings, or 1 Chronicles? *2 Kings.*
2. What was the name of the northern kingdom? *Israel.*
3. God had sent prophets to warn Israel. Which of the following were two of these prophets: Amos, Ahab, Hosea? *Amos, Hosea.*
4. How many years had God been patient, waiting for Israel to repent: 100, 250, or 500? *250 years.*
5. What was the name of the king who invaded Israel: Hoshea or Shalmaneser? *Shalmaneser.*
6. Shalmaneser was the king of what nation? *Assyria.*
7. What word means to try to take over a city by surrounding it? *Besiege.*
8. The Assyrians besieged Israel's capital city. What was the name of this city? *Samaria.*
9. How long did the siege of Samaria last: three days, three months, or three years? *Three years.*
10. True or false: The Assyrians allowed the Israelites to stay in their homes. *False. They took them away to live in Assyrian/foreign cities.*
11. God was angry with Israel because they worshipped *what?* *False gods/idols.*
12. Who warned the Israelites that they would be punished for their sins? *Prophets.*
13. True or false: The Israelites refused to listen to the prophets' warnings. *True.*
14. Which attribute of God means he cannot sin and hates sin? *Holy.*
15. Which attribute of God means he must punish sin? *Just.*
16. The Israelites did not listen to God's commands given in his laws and by the prophets. How can we listen for God's commands today? What has he given us? *(Allow several students to answer.) His Word/ the Bible, parents, teachers, pastors.*
17. What happens if we choose to ignore God's commands? *Trouble, punishment.*
18. Who can fill in the missing words from the memory verse? *Read the verse, pausing before several words to let a student say the word that comes next. Proverbs 3:11-12 My son, do not _____ (despise) the LORD's discipline or be _____ (weary) of his reproof, for the LORD _____ (reproves) him whom he loves, as a _____ (father) the son in whom he delights. (ESV)*
