- 1. Which king of Babylon made a golden image? Nebuchadnezzar.

- 3. Which men from Judah refused to worship the golden image? Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.
- 4. Who told the king that the three Jewish men disobeyed the king's command? Some Chaldeans.
- 5. What choice did the king give the three men when they were called before him? Worship the golden image or be thrown into the fiery furnace.
- 6. Why did Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refuse to obey the king's command? Because the king's command was against God's command to worship him alone.
- 7. How did the king feel when they didn't obey him? Furious, angry.
- 8. What happened to the guards who bound Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego and threw them into the fiery furnace? They were killed by the fire because it was so hot.
