K–1st Review Questions

1. Is the book of Malachi in the Old Testament or in the New Testament? *Old Testament.*
2. What were the priests not doing right? *They were offering imperfect animals (sick, blind, lame).*
3. What did God say about offering sick or blind animals? Was it okay, not too bad, or evil? *Evil.*
4. Why was it evil to offer God animals that were sick: the animals didn't like it, it made people sick, it didn't show respect to God? *It didn't show respect to God.*
5. Would the priests' bad offerings bring a blessing or a curse? *Curse.*
6. What was the priests' job: to teach the people how to obey God, to show the people a good example of worship, or both? *Both.*
7. Instead of teaching the people the right way to worship, what were the priests causing the people to do? *To disobey and sin against God.*
8. What kind of sacrifice pleases God—a broken and contrite what? *A broken and contrite heart. A heart that is sorry for sin.*
9. What kind of attitude should we have in our hearts toward God? *(Allow several students to answer.) An attitude of worship, love, honor, sorrow for our sins.*
10. What are some good ways to worship God? *(Allow several students to answer.) Praise him, pray, obey him by doing good things because we love him, read/listen to God's Word, etc.*
