Review Questions

- 1. The southern kingdom of Judah was ruled by whose descendants? King David's.
- 2. What was the name of the northern kingdom that was destroyed by the Assyrians because they refused to repent and turn back to God? *Israel*.
- 3. Who was the mother of King Ahaziah who decided she should rule when her son was killed? Athaliah.
- 4. Who were Athaliah's parents, an evil king and queen of Israel? Ahab and Jezebel.
- 5. Who did Athaliah start killing so they couldn't take the throne? Her grandsons, the princes, Ahaziah's sons.
- 6. Which son of Ahaziah was rescued by his aunt, Jehosheba, before Athaliah could kill him? Joash.
- 7. Where did Jehosheba take Joash to hide him from Athaliah? The house of the Lord; the temple.
- 8. Who was Jehosheba's husband and the high priest? Jehoiada.
- 9. How long did Joash remain hidden in the temple? Six years.
- 10. Who did Jehoiada get to help him crown Joash as king? The captains of the guard and their men.
- 11. With the support and protection of the guards, Jehoiada anointed Joash king in the temple in front of the people. Name one of the two things Jehoiada gave Joash. *Crown and the testimony (law of God).*
- 12. How old was Joash when he was crowned king? Seven years old.
- **13.** What happened to Athaliah when she came to see what the noise and celebration was about? She was taken away and killed for her crimes.
- 14. What word did Athaliah cry out when she saw Joash crowned king? It is the crime of trying to take over a country by removing the people in charge. *Treason*.
- **15.** Why was it important that God protected Joash from being killed? God saved him to keep his promise to continue the royal line of David.
- **16.** What good thing did Joash do as king? *Restored/repaired the temple.*
- 17. What did Joash place at the temple so people could give money for the repairs? Chest.
- 18. To whom did Joash give the money to make the repairs: the priests, the Levites, or workers like carpenters and masons? *Workers like carpenters and masons*.
- 19. After Jehoiada's death, Joash listened to the princes of Judah for advice. What did they decide to do? Abandon the Lord and worship idols.
- 20. Who stood up before the people and delivered God's message that they were breaking his commandments? *Jehoiada*'s son, *Zechariah*, a priest.
- 21. What did Joash command the people to do to Zechariah because he didn't like what he said? Stone *Techariah*.
- **22.** What punishment did God send because of the sins of Joash and the people? The Syrian army came to defeat them and wound Joash.
- 23. Because of his actions at the end of his reign, how is King Joash remembered: as a good king or as a bad king? *Bad king*.
 - Bonus: Which king of Judah was married to Athaliah? Joram (Jehoram).
