



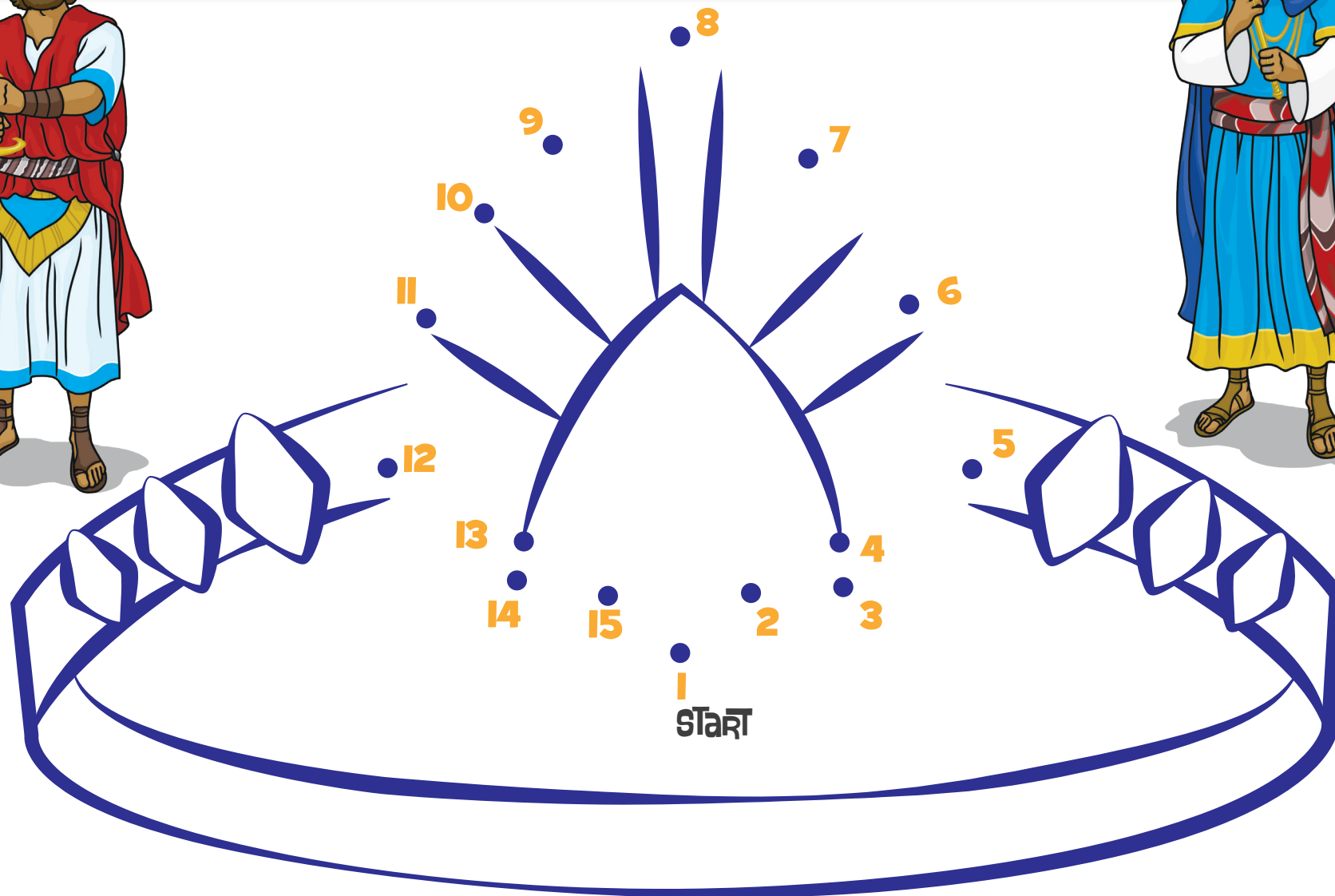

What You Heard *In the Word*

1. When David was upset because his family was captured and his men were angry, where did David find strength? What did he do? *David prayed and asked God for help.*
2. Was David happy or sad when he heard King Saul and his son Jonathan had died? *He was very sad.*
3. After waiting many years, what did David become when he was 30 years old? *King over all Israel.*
