- 1. What people lived to the north of Israel? Syrians.
- 2. Who was taken captive on a raid and became a servant to the Syrian army commander's wife? *Israelite girl.*
- 3. What was the name of the famous army commander who captured the Israelite girl? *Naaman*.
- 4. What incurable disease did Naaman have? Leprosy.
- 5. Who did the servant girl say could heal leprosy? The prophet in Samaria, Elisha.
- 6. Name one thing Naaman brought with him as a gift. Silver, gold, clothing.
- 7. Who sent Naaman to the king of Israel with a letter requesting he be healed? King of Syria.
- 8. What did Jehoram, the king of Israel, do when he read the letter? Tore his clothes and was distressed.
- 9. What was Jehoram worried would happen if Naaman were not healed? The Syrians would attack Israel.
- 10. What did Elisha do when he heard how upset Jehoram was? He said to send Naaman to him.
- **11. What did Elisha do when Naaman arrived at his house?** He sent a servant to give him instructions to wash seven times in the Jordan to be healed.
- 12. How did Naaman respond to the servant's instructions? He was angry.
