- 1. True or False: Moses got to enter the promised land. False.
- 2. Where did God have Moses go to see the promised land before he died? A mountain.
- 3. How old was Moses when he died: 40, 80, or 120? 120.
- 4. Who did God choose to lead the Israelites after Moses died? Joshua.
- 5. God commanded Joshua to be strong and what? Courageous.
- 6. What city did Joshua send the two spies to? Jericho.
- 7. What made Jericho a tough city to attack? It was protected by walls.
- 8. What woman helped the spies? *Rahab*.
- 9. Where did Rahab hide the spies? On her roof underneath the flax.
- **10.** Where was Rahab's house built? In the wall of the city.
- 11. Who found out about the spies and sent men to capture them? King of Jericho.
- 12. Where did Rahab tell the king's men that the spies had gone? Out the gate of the city.
- **13.** How did Rahab help the spies escape the city and the men chasing them? She let them down from her window with a rope.
- **14.** Why were the people in Jericho terrified of the Israelites? What had they heard about God? They knew about the parting of the Red Sea and the Israelites' victories over the Amorite kings, Sihon and Og.

- 18. Because of Rahab's faith, what attribute did God show by saving Rahab and her family during the battle? *Mercy/merciful*.
- 19. Rahab married an Israelite. Which two important people came from her family? King David. Jesus.
- 20. What attribute did God show to Rahab by allowing her to be included in Jesus' family line even though she didn't deserve it? *Grace/gracious*.
