



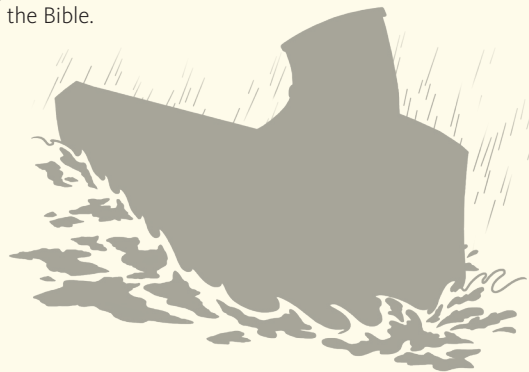

What You Heard *In the Word*

God told Noah to build an Ark that would not sink! The Ark God told Noah to build is nothing like many of the play arks we see today. Those arks would not have survived the Flood!

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

3. How do we know these things about the real Ark? *It's in the Bible.*
