Lesson 41

- 1. Rebekah became pregnant with twins. What did God tell her about her children? She would have two children who would each become a nation. The older would serve the younger.
- 2. Which brother liked to hunt outdoors, making him Isaac's favorite? *Esau*.
- 3. What word means that the firstborn son received a double portion of his parents' wealth and got to be in charge when his father died? *Birthright*.
- 4. What did Esau want from Jacob when he returned from hunting all day and was tired and hungry? *Lentil stew*.
- 5. What did Jacob ask Esau for in exchange for some stew? His birthright.
- **6.** How did Esau feel about his birthright? He despised it, considered it worthless.

- 7. What did Isaac ask Esau to do before he would give him the blessing? Go hunting and prepare him a meal.
