## **Review Questions**

- 1. Name one of the men God promised to give a special land. (Ask several students.) Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Moses.
- 2. God promised the Israelites that if they were obedient he would send *what* before them to protect them and defeat their enemies? *His angel*.
- 3. How many spies did Moses send into the promised land? Twelve.
- **4.** Name one fruit that the spies brought back from the land. (Ask several students.) Grapes, figs, pomegranates.
- 5. How many days were the spies in the land of Canaan? Forty.
- 6. The land was described as a good land, flowing with what? Milk and honey.
- 7. How did the ten spies describe the people living in the land? Tall, strong, giant.
- 8. What were the cities like? Large and fortified.
- 9. Who told the Israelites that the land was good and they could take it over with God on their side? *Caleb and Joshua.*
- 10. Who made the Israelites fear and doubt God's promise when they described the fortified cities and giant people? *Ten spies*.
- **11.** What did the people want to do when they heard the bad report of the ten spies? Choose a new leader and return to Egypt.
- 12. What did the people plan to do to Joshua and Caleb? Stone them.
- **13.** How did God punish the people for rebelling against him? They wandered in the wilderness for 40 years until the adults died. The adults never entered the promised land.
- **14.** How did God punish the ten spies? He killed them with a plague.
- 15. How did God reward the faith of Joshua and Caleb? He said they would enter the promised land.
- **16.** What is the reference of our memory verse? Deuteronomy 7:9.
- 17. What word in the memory verse describes how God keeps his covenant (promises) and love toward those who love him and keep his commandments? *Faithful*.

Bonus: What tribe was Joshua from? Ephraim.

Bonus: What tribe was Caleb from? *Judah*.
