

Review Questions

1. What do we call the commands God gave Moses and the Israelites at Mount Sinai? *The Ten Commandments.*
2. What did God write the Ten Commandments on for Moses: paper, animal hide, or two stone tablets? *Two stone tablets.*
3. How long was Moses up on the mountain: 1 year, 40 days, or 2 weeks? *40 days.*
4. What did the Israelites want Aaron to make for them: an idol, a roasted calf for dinner, or a bonfire? *An idol.*
5. What did the Israelites give Aaron to make the idol? *Gold rings.*
6. What did the idol that Aaron made look like? *A golden calf.*
7. What two commandments were the Israelites breaking? *The first two: 1) You shall have no other gods before me, 2) You shall not make for yourself an idol or bow down to it.*
8. What did the Israelites give the golden calf credit for that God had actually done? *Brought them out of Egypt.*
9. What was God going to do to punish the Israelites for their idolatry (worshipping the idol)? *Destroy them.*
10. What did Moses do to save the Israelites from God's anger? *He prayed and asked God to show them mercy.*
11. How did God show mercy? *He did not destroy all the Israelites.*
12. What did Moses do when he came down the mountain and saw the golden calf and the people acting out of control? *He broke the stone tablets with the Ten Commandments.*
13. What did Moses do to the golden calf: burned it, polished it, or smashed it with the stone tablets? *Burned it.*
14. What did Aaron do when Moses asked him what happened: blamed the people, confessed his sin, or blamed Moses? *Blamed the people.*
15. How did the golden calf get there: it popped out of the fire, Aaron fashioned it by hand, or the craftsmen built it? *Aaron fashioned it by hand.*
16. What two attributes of God did we see in the lesson today? *Mercy (merciful) and justice (just).*
17. What punishment did God send because of the Israelites' idolatry? *A plague.*
18. Who can say the memory verse? *Allow several students to try reciting the verse.*
