- 4. Was Matthew writing mainly for Gentiles or Jews, who knew about Old Testament prophecies? Jews.
- 5. Matthew chapter 1 begins with Jesus' what? It is the study of who is part of a family. Genealogy.
- 6. What two Old Testament names are given in Matthew 1:1 as part of Jesus' genealogy? David and Abraham.
- 7. Matthew wanted his readers to understand that Jesus was the eternal what, promised in the Old Testament? *King.*
