Review Questions

- 2. Why didn't the brothers recognize Joseph? He looked and sounded Egyptian. It had been many years since they had seen him. He was a ruler with an Egyptian name.
- 3. What did Joseph decide to do to his brothers? Test them to see if they had changed.
- 4. What did Joseph accuse his brothers of being? Spies.
- 5. Why were the brothers worried when they found their money in their grain sacks? They were afraid it would look like they'd stolen it.
- 6. Who did Joseph tell the brothers to bring back with them next time? Benjamin.
- 7. Why didn't Jacob want Benjamin to go to Egypt? He was worried something bad would happen to him.
- **8.** Why did Joseph tell his servant to put his silver cup in Benjamin's sack? To see if his brothers would stand up for him and protect him.
