- 1. What book of the Bible did we study today? Exodus.
- 2. What did God command Pharaoh to do through Moses and Aaron? Let the Israelites (his people) go.
- 3. Pharaoh said the Israelites were lazy and commanded that they collect their own *what* to make bricks? *Straw.*
- **4.** What happened when Aaron's staff and the magicians' staffs turned into snakes? *Aaron's snake ate the others.*
- 5. Are the plagues God sent in Egypt a sickness or a severe judgment? A severe judgment.
- 6. What did God want the Egyptians to learn about him through the plagues? That he is the one true God.
- 7. What was the first plague? Water turned to blood.
- 8. What happened after God killed all the frogs he brought up from the river in the second plague? The people gathered the dead frogs in piles and the land stank.
- 9. During which plague did God start protecting the Israelites: the first, fourth, or sixth? *The fourth plague of flies*.
- 10. Which plague made the Egyptians "unclean"? Boils.
- 11. Which plague began when Aaron struck the dust with his staff: gnats, frogs, or darkness? Gnats.
- 12. True or false: the plague on the livestock made the animals of the Egyptians and the Israelites get sick and die. False. None of the Israelites' animals were affected.
- **13.** How did God show mercy to the Egyptians before the plague of hail? He sent Moses to warn them that it was coming so they could bring their people and animals inside.
- **14.** What happened to those who ignored God's warning of the hailstorm? Their servants and animals were killed.
- 15. What happened to all the remaining crops and green plants after the hail? Locusts ate it all.
- **16.** What plague showed that God was more powerful than the sun god? *The ninth plague of darkness.*
- **17.** How did Pharaoh show that he had a hard heart toward God? He kept refusing to obey God's command to let the Israelites go.
- **18.** What attribute means God as all-powerful? *Omnipotent.*
