

# Crown the King

## Materials

- ☐ One Crown Card for each student (next page)
- ☐ Solomon Poster Pages (following pages)
- ☐ Tape
- ☐ Blindfold (dish towel, scarf, or necktie)
- ☐ Optional: poster putty

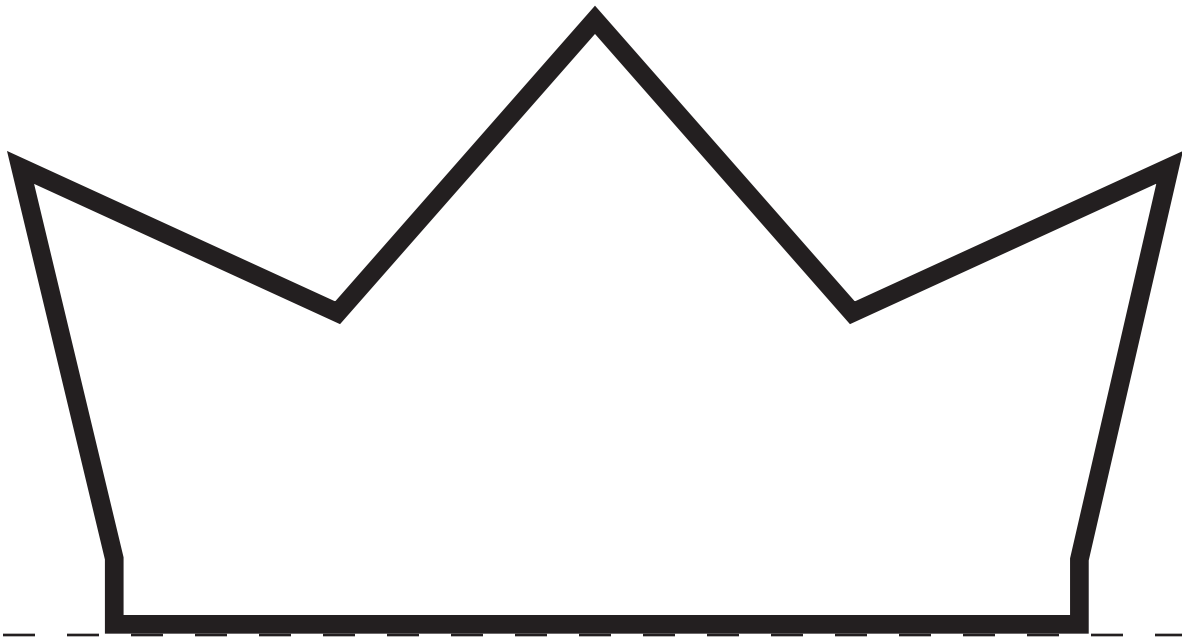
## Instructions

*Print and cut out one Crown Card for each student and have them write their name on their card. Print one copy of each Solomon Poster Page and tape them together to make one large poster. Attach the poster to the wall low enough for students to reach.*

*Have students line up. Put the blindfold on the first student and gently spin him around a few times then direct him toward the poster. Have the student attach his crown to the poster, trying to get as close to the head as possible. Remove the blindfold and allow each student to have a turn. Whoever places their crown closest to the top of the head on the poster wins the game. Repeat if time allows.*

## Suggested Discussion

When King David was very old, he chose his son Solomon to be the next king. God blessed Solomon with wisdom so he could rule the people well.
