1. Who were the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob? *The Israelites.*
2. Who did God promise to send before the Israelites to guide and protect them if they were obedient? *His angel.*
3. What did God mean when he said he would “blot out” the enemies? *Completely destroy them.*
4. How many spies did Moses send into the promised land? *Twelve.*
5. Name one fruit that the spies brought back from the land. *Allow several students to answer. Grapes, figs, pomegranates.*
6. How many days were the spies in the land of Canaan? *Forty.*
7. The land was described as a good land, flowing with what? *Milk and honey.*
8. How did the ten spies describe the people living in the land? *Tall, strong, giant.*
9. What did the spies say they felt like next to these giant people? *Grasshoppers.*
10. What were the cities like? *Large with high walls.*
11. What did the people want to do when they heard the bad report of the ten spies? *Choose a new leader and return to Egypt.*
12. Because of their fear, what did the people plan to do to Joshua and Caleb? *Stone them.*
13. Who could not enter the promised land because of their disobedience? *The adults 20 years old and older.*
14. How long would the people wander in the wilderness? *40 years.*
15. How did God reward the faith of Joshua and Caleb? *He said they would enter the promised land.*
16. What is the reference of our memory verse? *Deuteronomy 7:9.*
17. What word in the memory verse describes an attribute of God that means he keeps his covenant (promises) and love toward those who love him and keep his commandments? *Faithful.*
