- 7. The land was described as a good land, flowing with what? Milk and honey.
- 8. How did the ten spies describe the people living in the land? Tall, strong, giant.
- 9. What did the spies say they felt like next to these giant people? Grasshoppers.
- 10. What were the cities like? Large with high walls.
- **11.** What did the people want to do when they heard the bad report of the ten spies? Choose a new leader and return to Egypt.
- 12. Because of their fear, what did the people plan to do to Joshua and Caleb? Stone them.
- 13. Who could not enter the promised land because of their disobedience? The adults 20 years old and older.
- 14. How long would the people wander in the wilderness? 40 years.
- 15. How did God reward the faith of Joshua and Caleb? He said they would enter the promised land.
