

# Review Questions

## K-1<sup>st</sup> Review Questions

1. Who were the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel)? *The Israelites.*
2. Who did God promise to send to guard and guide the people? *His angel.*
3. What did God say he would do about the enemies living in the land? *He would help the Israelites fight them.*
4. How many spies did Moses send into the promised land? *Twelve.*
5. Name one fruit that the spies brought back from the land. *Allow several students to answer. Grapes, figs, pomegranates.*
6. What does it mean that the land was flowing with milk and honey? *It was a good land.*
7. What did the ten spies say the people in the land were like? *Tall, strong, giant.*
8. What did the spies say they felt like next to these giant people? Hint: it's a kind of insect that hops. *Grasshoppers.*
9. What did the cities have all around them that would make it hard to attack them? *Walls.*
10. What were the names of the two spies who trusted God to help them take the land? *Joshua and Caleb.*
11. The people let their fear take over and got angry. What did they want to do to Joshua and Caleb when they were arguing? *Kill them with stones.*
12. What was the Israelites' punishment for not trusting God and going into the land? *They could not enter the promised land.*
13. How long did the people have to wander in the wilderness: 10 years, 3 weeks, or 40 years? *40 years.*
14. What did God say about Joshua and Caleb since they trusted him? *He said they would enter the promised land.*
15. Who else would be able to enter the promised land later? *The young people.*

1. Who did God make a promise to when God told him to move to Canaan a long time ago? *Abraham.*
2. Canaan is the land God promised to give Abraham and his descendants. Who were these descendants who came from Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob's (Israel's) family? *The Israelites.*
