## **Review Questions**

- 1. What special ability did God give to Daniel? *Interpret/understand dreams*.
- 2. What king of Babylon was ruling about 20 years after Nebuchadnezzar's death? *Belshazzar*.
- 3. What did King Belshazzar do for his leaders when he knew they were surrounded by the Medo-Persian army? *Have a feast*.
- 4. When the king and his people were feasting and drinking, what bad decision did Belshazzar make? To bring out the vessels taken from God's temple and drink from them.
- 5. What was wrong with Belshazzar using the vessels (cups) from the temple to drink out of? He was not treating the vessels as holy or respecting/honoring God. He and the people were drunk and praising false gods.
- 6. What miraculous sign did God send to get King Belshazzar's attention during the feast? A hand appeared and wrote on the wall.
- 7. How did Belshazzar feel when he saw the handwriting on the wall? *Alarmed, terrified.*
- 8. Who did the king call for to try to interpret the words on the wall? His wise men: enchanters, Chaldeans, astrologers.
- 9. Who told the king about Daniel and how he'd interpreted dreams for King Nebuchadnezzar? *The queen.*
- **10.** What sins did Daniel warn the king about? *Pride, idolatry, refusing to honor the true God.*
- 11. Who did Daniel say the writing on the wall was from? The hand of God, the true God (not gods of silver, gold etc.).
- 12. Name one of the three words that were on the wall. Mene, Tekel, Parsin (Peres).

- 13. Daniel said that Mene meant that God had numbered the days of the king or the kingdom? *The kingdom (of Babylon).*
- 14. Tekel meant that Belshazzar had been weighed in the balances and found to be perfect or wanting? *Wanting*.
- 15. Peres meant that the kingdom would be divided and given to the Medes and the Persians or the Greeks and the Romans? The Medes and the Persians.
- 16. How soon did the message that Belshazzar's kingdom would fall take place: that night, the next day, or the following year? *That night*.
- 17. Who became king after Belshazzar was killed? *Darius the Mede.*
- **18.** What law was King Darius tricked by jealous men into making? A law that people could pray only to the king.
- 19. What did Daniel continue to do even though he knew about the law? Pray three times a day to God.
- 20. What punishment was Darius forced to give Daniel, even though he didn't want to? *Throw him in the lions' den*.
- **21.** How did God protect Daniel? He sent an angel to close the lions' mouths.
- 22. How did Darius feel when he learned that God had saved Daniel? He was glad.
- 23. What did Darius do after he had Daniel taken out of the lions' den? He ordered the men who accused Daniel to be thrown into the den with their families; he commanded all people to fear the God of Daniel.
