- ☐ Joash fold-over pictures (next page)
- ☐ Craft sticks
- ☐ Tape
- ☐ Crayons or markers

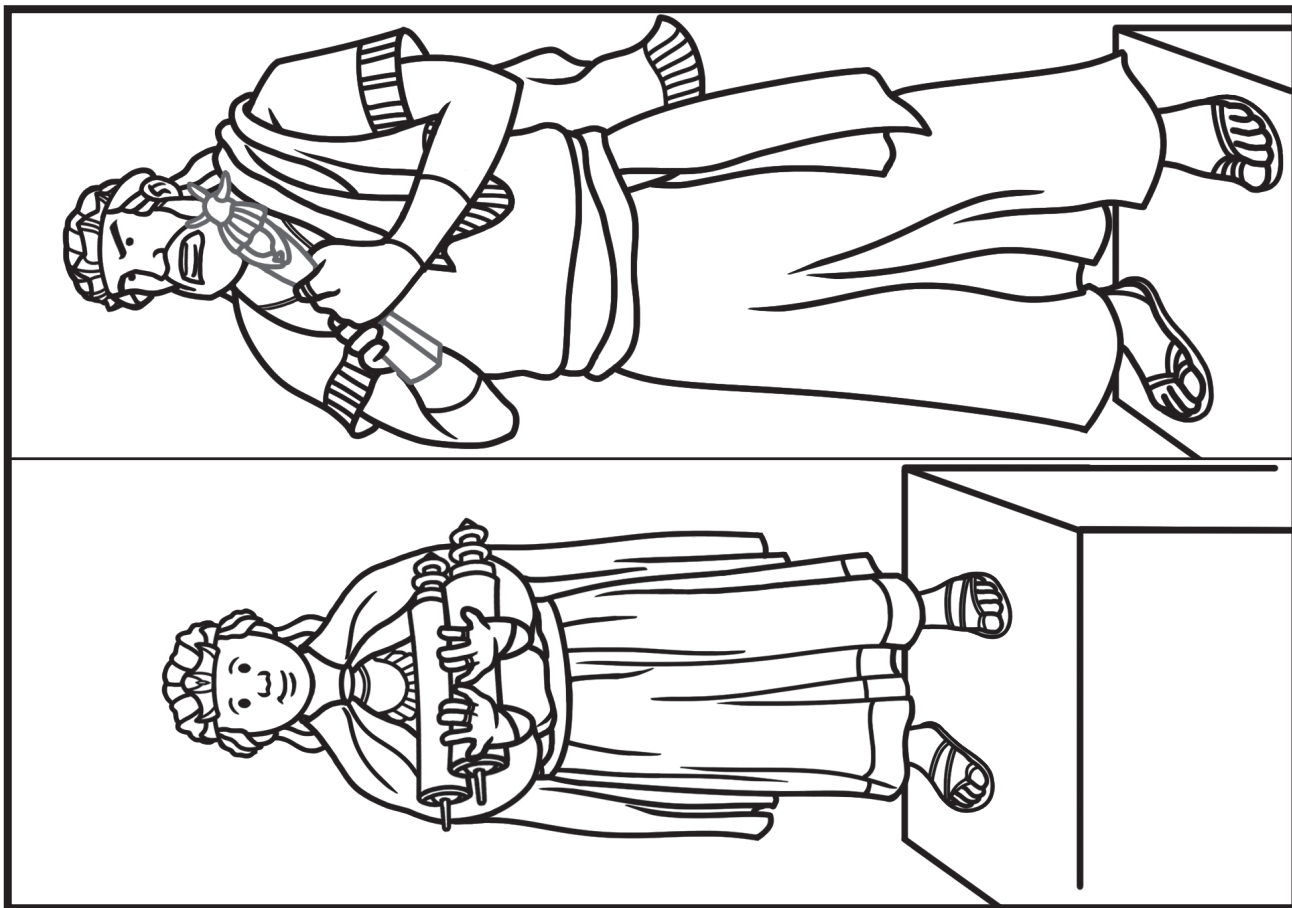
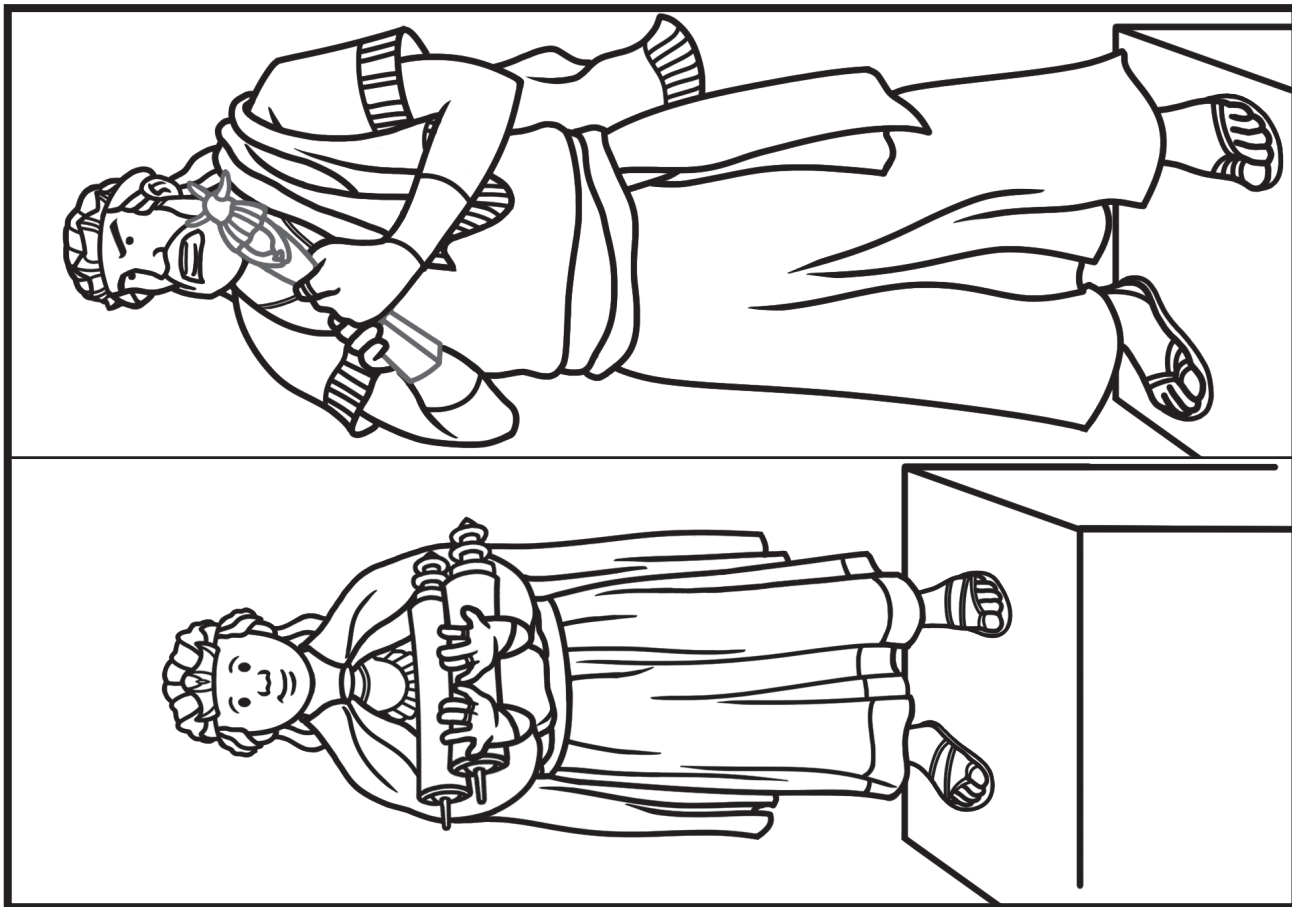
Instructions

Print and cut out one fold-over picture (young Joash and older Joash) for each student. Have students color both sides of the picture. Tape a craft stick to the back of one side then fold the picture on the center line. Tape the sides closed and secure the bottom edge around the stick.

Suggested Discussion

Look at the young Joash side of your puppet. Joash started out as a good king when he was only seven years old. Jehoiada taught him the laws of the Lord, and Joash did his job well.

Now turn your puppet to the other side. After Jehoiada died, Joash listened to people who didn't love God or care about obeying his laws. Joash soon turned to worshipping false gods and idols, and God had to punish him because of his sin.
